

Student Council at ILSW consists of 3 representatives from each homeroom in grades 6th - 8th. Members serve as leaders and representatives of our school's student body. Because of this we have high expectations of their performance as students, in and out of school. Student Council members must abide by the policies as stated in both the Family and Extra-Curricular handbook. To be eligible (in good standing) to participate in extracurricular activities and events, the following requirements must be met:

The student must meet academic eligibility qualifications. A student earning a cumulative quarterly grade in any subject lower than a C- due to missing/incomplete grades will be suspended from participation in StuCo activities. The academic progress of all students in the student council will be reviewed on a weekly basis.

Also, the school does view student council members as student leaders, and we hold them to a high behavior standard, in and out of the school setting, expecting them to consistently perform in a God-pleasing manner. Students that receive 3 behavior marks within a semester may be removed from Student Council. Any behavior that warrants an in-school or out-of-school suspension, will result in automatic removal from the council. Whether or not an ineligible student can rejoin the council at a later time will be decided on a case-by-case basis by student council leaders and/or advisors. Advisors will call an official review meeting to bring said student(s) in with advisors and administration to discuss probationary reinstatement. Student Council Staff Advisors may also have additional requirements for reinstatement.
