October BOD Meeting Minutes approved via e-mail.

MLT Reports

Senior Pastor's Report – The BOD reviewed the submitted report.

- Chris Hall inquired about the upcoming Advent services, ILS Christmas programs, and involvement of ILCSW school children in the services.
- Joel Mueller asked about the Business Manager and the open Finance Manager & Human Resource Manager duties within the scope of a business administrator role. Discussion regarding staffing needs within a church of Immanuel's size.

Principal's Report – The BOD reviewed the report. Discussion regarding Immanuel's enrollment trends and future parking needs, as well as the open teaching position with Joann Massmann's planned retirement (7th-8th Grade ELA) at the end of the school year.

Business Manager's Report – No report

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Treasurer's Report – Carol Waddell reviewed the report, noting expenses, which are down from budget, positive giving, and the steady pace of online worship service viewership. Carol commented that as we enter into the winter months, weather plays a significant role in expense levels. Carol also brought to the attention of the group the status of the BOD Fund, which is depleted.

Forrest Van Ness made a motion to accept the Treasure Report as presented. Grant Goris seconded the motion. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

Property Manager Report – The BOD reviewed the submitted information, i.e., Property & Building Ministry update. Carol Waddell commented on the positive impact Mike Schlipp continues to make on the maintenance and upkeep of the property.

OLD BUSINESS

Information Security (on-going item) – Chris Hall inquired about IT security training for the school staff.

Balcony/Sanctuary Improvements Committee – Roger Huslage reported that each of three contractors have submitted bids for proposed improvements to the balcony and sanctuary, noting that bids do not include either architect or permit fees. The committee will meet after Thanksgiving 2021 to review bids in detail, followed by a committee recommendation to the BOD. Targeted May through July 2022 work dates, when school is not in session, will necessitate a timely response to contractors. A Special Voters Meeting, with BOD recommendation to the voters, is slated in the next six weeks.

Constitution Review Plans – Tom Ruff commented on the open forum held on November 3. The BOD affirmed bringing forward for approval the proposed Constitution and the Statement of Belief to the stewards of Immanuel at the upcoming voters meeting.

BOD Christmas Dinner Plans – Carol Waddell and Bonnie Schulte shared details for the Thursday, December 18, BOD Christmas celebration, which is to be held at Crossroads Brewery with A Touch of Class Catering by Christi providing the meal. BOD members are responsible for their meal expense.

NEW BUSINESS

Tom Ruff shared that Russ Hoppe will serve as Immanuel's congregational representative to the Lutheran Foundation, an organization providing grant assistance to congregations to support community outreach work.

The BOD conducted their self-review.

Members closed the meeting with the Lord's Prayer.

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Joel Mueller made a motion to adjourn. Chris Hall seconded the motion. Motion approved by unanimous vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.

Several cafeteria kitchen repairs to freezers, refrigerators and oven, everything currently working as it should

Getting everything sealed and winterized.

Fire Marshall inspection on 11/10 went very well. No issues were reported.

Our alarm systems communicate to our monitoring service over phone lines currently, and that system is an ongoing problem as the lines are not very good at carrying the digital signals. We are constantly addressing trouble codes and alarms because of this. Per the advice of our monitoring company, we are installing a cellular communicator which will act more like a cell phone and completely bypass these phone lines. This was a one-time \$500 cost and an additional \$24/month on our monitoring service but expected to be a lot less hassle and trouble alarms.
